- Tecan just finished another very successful business year 2018

- CEO David Martyr to retire after 6 ½ years at the helm of the company
- The Board of Directors has appointed Achim von Leoprechting, Head of Partnering Business division, as the new CEO
 - Assumes CEO role on April 1, 2019
 - Continues in his current role in addition until a successor is appointed
- First internal succession in the history of Tecan
- Internal appointment also maximizes continuity of the corporate strategy



Achim von Leoprechting to become CEO of Tecan

- Joined Tecan in October 2013 as a member of the Management Board and Head of the Partnering Business division
- Under his leadership, Tecan's Partnering Business has grown by an average rate of more than 9% per year

- His deep understanding of end markets and application expertise will help Tecan to further benefit from the 'Century of Biology'
